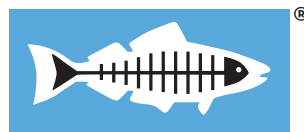

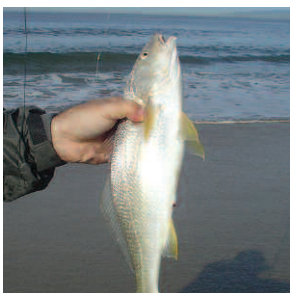

Tournament Rules & Regulations

GAME PLAN:

Check-in is at 6am which is 1 hour before the start of the tournament.

OneSurfFly will begin promptly at 7am and end at 9am.

YOU MUST SIGN-IN TO COMPETE.

This is a fly fishing only contest!

All contestants must sign a contestant liability waiver prior to competing.

Each participating angler is to provide one deadly saltwater surf fly pattern on the morning of the OSF tournament.

Each participant must wear a visible 2009 CA fishing license during competition.

Each angler must provide their own fly rod, reel and line.

Each angler must wear sun glasses, prescription glasses or safety glasses during this competition.

Anglers must be at least 100 feet from each other.

Leaders and tippets can be of any strength and retied if they become worn.

All contestants must use only one fly for the entire tournament time slot of two hours.

A lost fly terminates your tournament session! No exceptions!

Each fish caught must be recorded by a tournament spotter.

All fish prior to a lost fly will be counted towards your score.

All fish must be fairly caught and not foul hooked!

Catches recorded without a spotter will not count.

For extra safety, spotters will watch for bystanders and insure anglers maintain a safe distance from anglers and pedestrians.

FLIES:

Each fly will be inspected by our team and approved before they can be entered.

All flies will be logged in, enveloped and thrown into a brown paper bag.

Additional proven patterns will be added to sweeten the pot for those that do not wish to enter a fly.

Each angler will pick one mystery fly prior to fishing.

VERY IMPORTANT SAFETY MESSAGE:

Spotters will have whistles. (Whistles are to be used ONLY in an extreme situation)

If a whistle is blown it means you are either wading too deep,

you are crowding another angler or a pedestrian is in close proximity to your back cast.

A blown whistle means to immediately stop casting, those that have the fly already in the water may continue to retrieve the fly only until otherwise instructed.

Any angler disregarding a blown whistle be immediately disqualified.

Safety and having a great time is to be of paramount importance to all of us!

Let's all have a fun morning on the water!
